1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Baulkham Hills Junior Motorcycling Training Club (BHJTMC), will conduct MNSW Minikhana State Championship Round 2 for Demonstration Class, Junior and Senior motorcycles at the Ian Packer Training Centre, 85 Redmayne Road, Horsley Park, on 19th May 2019

2. **JURISDICTION:**

- 2.1. The above-mentioned Minikhana State Championship Round meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Limited who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number Permit 5/19/I/23997 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licences.
- 2.2. This meeting and is only open to the following Minikhana Clubs: Baulkham Hills JMTC, Blacktown Minibike Club, Junior Trials MCC, Hornsby Junior Dirt Bike Club, Penrith Minibike Club, Sutherland PCYC.

2.3. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, the By-Laws of Motorcycling NSW and any final instructions.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. *ENTRIES*:

- Entries open on the 22nd April 2019 at 6am forthwith and close 11pm on 16th May 2019. Entries can ONLY be done online via Ridernet. To enter online go to www.bhjmtc.com.au or Ridernet https://osm-ma.omnisportsmanagement.com/EventManager/EM RegEventInformation.aspx?EventId=39%2bRiPMu1VUcU7%2fl3 qDS0j6y81bc7yXX and find event and follow instructions.
- 3.2 Only entries received on the official via this channel and are accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- NOTE: LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED OR REJECTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE RACE SECRETARY, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE RACE COMMITTEE OR HOSTING CLUB COMMITTEE, AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CLUB HOSTING THE MEETING. THERE IS NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY.

4. INSURANCE:

- 2.1 National Capital Benefits Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 2.2 Personal Accident and Ambulance Insurance is the responsibility of the individual.
- 2.3 IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT SUCH INSURANCE COVER.

3. <u>MEDICAL SERVICES:</u>

- 3.1 Medical services will be available on the day from the beginning of competition through to the completion of competition.
- 3.2 Medical services will be provided by Beneficial Safety

4. ENTRY FEE:

4.1 Entry Fees: Due by midnight 16th May 2019

 1^{st} rider = \$50.00

2nd & subsequent riders = \$50.00

50CC DEMONSTRATION FEES ARE \$35 per rider

4.2 Payment by Ridernet Credit/Debit Card or electronic funds transfers (by approval of the Race Secretary).

Late Entries after 16TH May will incur a \$25.00 per rider late fee. NO Late entries will be accepted on the day.

5. **CLASSES OF COMPETITION:**

Senior Combined 85/100cc 2-str or 150cc 4-str

Junior BW A 85/100cc 2-str or 150cc 4-str, Junior BW B 85/100cc 2-str, or 150cc 4-str Junior BW C 85/100cc 2-str or 150cc 4-str

A 85cc 2-str or 150cc 4-str, B 85cc 2-str or 150cc 4-str, C 85cc 2-str or 150cc 4-str

A 65cc, B 65cc, C 65cc

A Mini Wheels, B Mini Wheels, C Mini Wheels

A 50cc Auto, B 50cc Auto, C 50cc Auto

50cc Demonstration (Non-competitive)

6. <u>AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:</u>

- 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in each grade will be awarded with a Trophy.
- 6.2 All 50cc Demonstration Class entrants will receive an award of the same or equal value.
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each event will be awarded an award by ways of Medallion.

7. <u>ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:</u>

7.1 To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be 4.

Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and/or prize money, will be at the discretion of the Host Club, subject to the G.C.R's and or the Steward on the Day.

8. RACE FORMAT:

7 Events are to be run

- Minicross
- Bending
- Orange
- Accelerate R8 (Figure 8)
- Non Footed Clover
- Ring Return
- Slow
- RUN OFF event if required Footed Clover
- 8.1 If a runoff is necessary, the event Footed Clover will be run.
- 8.2 Series: Scoring will be as per GCR's
- 8.3 Competition points for placing in each event.

9. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 9.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Minikhana competition.
- 9.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 9.3 No change of machine is permitted. One rider, one bike/One bike, one rider.
- 9.4 Noise &/or Fuel Testing may be carried out at any time during this meeting.

10. RIDING NUMBERS:

- 10.1 Competitors will be allocated their Motorcycling NSW Registered Riding Number or their preferred riding number if available. All others shall be allocated numbers at the Host Clubs discretion.
- Note: In lieu of colour requirements in GCR's for number plates riders may use an arm band issued by MNSW to determine their respective grade otherwise all number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCR's.

11. *GRID POSITIONS:*

Lane positions will be determined by a "draw of disks".

12. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of practice and all participants MUST attend. Riders' briefing sign-on sheets must be signed by the competitor as confirmation of attendance.

12. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

By order of Motorcycling NSW, random drug &/or alcohol testing of participants (i.e. officials, competitors, mechanics, pit crew and any other person associated with the control, direction and operation of the competition) may take place prior to, or at any time during this meeting.

13. *CODE OF CONDUCT:*

All participants, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and shall be enforced.

For the purposes of drug & alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 06:30am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being at the completion of racing.

15. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

- 15.1 Clock-wise Minicross Track B (50cc and Mini wheels B & C grades)
- 15.2 Clock-wise Minicross Track A (65cc, 85cc, 150cc 4 stroke and mini wheels A grade)

16. *STARTS*:

- 16.1 Elastic stretch start Minicross
- MX/SX PROCEDURE A 15 Second Board will be displayed to all riders. At the end of 10 seconds a 5 second board will be displayed. After a full 5 seconds, but not exceeding 10 seconds, the gates will drop.

17. *RACING*:

- 17.1 Sighting lap/laps will be conducted as per GCR. There will be a minimum of two sighting laps.
- 17.2 Number of laps in heats and finals to be advised at Riders Briefing

18. *NOISE*:

18.1 All machines must comply with the requirements of the GCR's.

19. **SPECIAL NOTES & WARNINGS:**

- 19.1 Parents or Guardians responsible for rider/s ARE required to assist in the running of events.
 - NOTE: failure to do so will result in the exclusion of the rider from the meeting.
- 19.2 All riders must present themselves fully dressed in riding attire with MA Licenses
- 19.3 All bikes the suspension, frame, brakes, wheel size, handle bars (plugged), motor size must be as per original manufacturers specification for that particular bike frame.
- 19.4 Fuel or noise testing may be conducted at this meeting
- 19.5 NO BIKES WILL BE RIDDEN OR STARTED IN THE CAR PARK
- 19.6 NO PUSHBIKES ALLOWED ON THE VENUE
- 19.7 Only one parent/guardian for demonstration class permitted inside fenced areas
- 19.8 No rider or spectator permitted on earth mounds.
- 19.9 Full Canteen will be in operation for Breakfast and Lunch
- 19.10 There is NO Camping on the Saturday Night before the event
- 19.11 Presentation will take place at the completion of all events and raffle
